The alliance with MIGway is the first SMS deal MSN has announced and is part of the MSN global strategy to provide mobile consumers with its best-of-breed services, such as MSN Hotmail and relevant integrated MSN features, through a reliable link to the wireless Web. The announced alliance follows the recent release of MSN Mobile 4.0, the latest version of MSN Mobile's platform that delivers customisable communications services to interactive pagers, mobile phones and handheld devices.

"Mobility is central to many Europeans' lives today, and with this alliance we are extending our capability to offer mobile carriers an immediate opportunity to generate revenue based on twoway SMS by providing their consumers with access to MSN Hotmail," said Judy Gibbons, vice president of MSN EMEA.

"With MSN communications services in enormous demand, this alliance also makes these services readily available to people on the move. Consumers want the ability to make the most of their PC-based communications services any time, any place and on any device. With MIGway, we have created the opportunity for European carriers to offer their customers access to MSN interactive communications services, such as MSN Hotmail, via the latest SMS technology direct to their mobile phones."
